EYFS – GLD = 62%, in-line with the expected National average post-COVID

Year 1 Phonics – 61% - this is a fall from pre-COVID data of 89% in 2019 - a new scheme and school interruptions haven't helped maintain previously, consistently high standards.

Year 2 Phonics – 92% - in line with Nationals.

Year 4 Timetables Check – 78% (within National ranges), with 35% scoring 4 errors or less (again, within National ranges) – for the first time of testing.

We are proud of these results – they reflect the struggles faced by pupils in Y2 and below, post-COVID and the impact our new curriculum is having for those KS2 pupils who have had less interruptions in their early years and are now in-line, at or exceeding National expectations after Tutoring and catch-up funding has been appropriately-used to close gaps.
